Service Day at Food For Thought

A group of volunteers can come to Food For Thought and volunteer in a number of ways, including serving in our Food Pantry, sorting food, and completing special projects.

Other special projects, such as construction and simpler tasks such as painting, arise from time to time.

A service day is also great if preceded by a food drive. Companies and other groups can bring the food drive donations that day and help sort and stock them in the pantry.

Pantry is open Monday-Thursday, making these the ideal days to do a project at Food For Thought. Construction projects are best done on Fridays, when the pantry is closed.

This project can accommodate groups of 5-30. Students age 16 and up are preferred, but smaller groups of middle school students can be accommodated.
